Highlights from the April 8th Regular Council Meeting

- Council approved Zoning By-law amendment ZBA-02-2024.
- Support and endorsement was given for Consent Applications B22-24 and B15-24 & B16-24.
- A request for road closure from Moderna Homes was considered, and Council directed staff to bring back a report to the next regular meeting.
- Council entertained a presentation from Stephen Tunks regarding the development project at the former Wolford school grounds. Direction was given to defer sending the Ministerial Zoning Order request until further information is provided.
- 3 Part Lot Control Exemption By-laws for Park View Homes were approved to be sent to UCLG for final approval.
- Council received a delegation from Ann Weir, Economic Development Manager from UCLG.
- Council received a delegation from Mary Kate Laphen regarding the 2023 Library Annual Report.
- The Flag/Acknowledgements Policy, amending By-law 15-2021, was approved.
- By-law 20-2024 was approved, being a by-law to enter into a Services Agreement Contract with OCWA for Water & Wastewater Services.
- The allocation of \$5000 was approved to be donated to Beth Donovan hospice from the Hospital Reserve Fund.
- Amendments were approved for the advisory committee Terms of References.
- Council received and approved the CWEAC recommendations as included in their first report to Council.
- The extension of the Interim CAO contract was approved.
- Council received a Code of Conduct Complaint Final Report from the Integrity Commissioner. The report will be posted publicly on the Village website.
- The month of April was proclaimed Parkinson's Awareness Month & April 11th as World Parkinson's Day.
- Council approved the annual bursary request for St. Michael's Catholic High School graduation.
