## FIBRE RECYCLABLES

Ensure that lightweight or loose material is not on top that will blow away and litter.

#### Place these items in the BLUE BOX:

- > Boxboard (with liner removed):
  - Cereal, cracker & cookie boxes; Pizza boxes; Egg paper cartons; Frozen food boxes; Fibreboard packaging (medicine boxes, toiletries boxes, toothpaste boxes, etc).
  - Shoe & tissue boxes; Detergent cartons; Toilet paper rolls; Paper towel and rolls.
- > Corrugated cardboard: Flatten all boxes before placing in the Blue Box. Tie together flattened large boxes; place beside or under the Blue Box. Insert smaller flattened boxes inside larger boxes.
- > Magazines; Catalogues; Calendars; Books; Clean paper shopping bags; Paper packaging; File folders; Posters; Telephone books.
- > Fine paper (writing, computer, fax or mail); Gift wrap paper; Greeting cards; Envelopes; Newspapers; Flyers (glossy or plain); Junk mail; Index cards; Shredded paper.

#### Do NOT put in the BLUE BOX:

- Waxed cardboard.
- Coffee and
- Pizza boxes with food
- Styrofoam.


- Soiled paper & boxes.
- drink cups.
- residue.

• Plastic bags.

## CONTAINER RECYCLABLES as of January 1, 2013

All items must be empty, rinsed and clean.

#### Place these items in the BLUE BOX:



- Soft drink; Juice & water bottles; LCBO bottles; Margarine & Yogurt tubs; Plastic ice cream containers; Plastic egg cartons; Tetra paks or Gable top cartons (milk, juice).
- Pails; Tubs; Plastic take-out trays; Windshield washer jugs; Household cleaning products; Laundry products.
- Personal hygiene (shampoo, conditioner, soap, etc).
- > Glass: Bottles; Jars; Jugs; but not windows, dishes or mirrors (broken or not).
- > Aluminum: Pie plates; Foil; Rigid foil containers; Trays; Soft drink cans.
- > Aerosol cans (empty); Metal lids; Steel cans; Food and beverage cans.

### Do NOT put in the BLUE BOX:

- Motor oil bottles/cans.
- Polystyrene (styrofoam
- Dishes, windows, mirrors (broken or not).

- Herbicide bottles/cans.
- trays, cups).
- Containers that held hazardous waste.

- Pesticide bottles/cans.
- Paint cans. Pots & pans.
- Film plastic (bags & cellophane).
- Plastic spines.

If a plastic container does not have a recycling logo 1 to 7, don't put it in the Blue Box.

Cables-cords (from computers, printers, extension cords, household electrical appliances, etc,) do not go in the Blue Box. They go in the E-Waste recycling bin at the Landfill.
