Highlights from the February 12th Regular Council Meeting

- Council received and endorsed Sewage Capacity Allocation requests for Lewis Street Developments and 212 Main Street West Development.
- Schedule E to By-law 44-2022 was amended to change the Planning fees as recommended by Senior Planner, Forbes Symon.
- Council received the Planning Report with Municipal Conditions of Draft Approval Application for the Carley Corner's Subdivision.
- The sewer camera investigation work east of St. Lawrence Street will be scheduled soon.
- By-law 04-2024 was approved to appoint Julia McCaugherty-Jansman as Clerk.
- The 2024 Water and Wastewater Rates were adopted through By-law 05-2024.
- Council received a delegation from Khristal Dillabough regarding a request to reduce the speed limit on Kilmarnock Road.
- Council received a delegation from Hunter McGill from Friends of the Rideau.
- Council approved and directed staff to enter into an agreement with ML Consulting to complete the 2024 Compensation Review.
- The 2024 Brush Amnesty schedule was approved.
- The CAO of Merrickville-Wolford was appointed as the municipal representative for the Steering Committee of the Rideau Corridor Landscape Strategy.
- Council scheduled a Budget Meeting for Thursday, February 15th at 3:00pm.
