Highlights from the March 11th Regular Council Meeting

- Council passed the 2024 Operating, Capital and Water & Wastewater Budgets and approved By-laws 12-2024 & 13-2024.
- An update was provided by Nigel Bellchamber on the Strategic Planning document. A public meeting is scheduled for March 18th at 7pm to gather comments for consideration, we look forward to your input.
- Council received a delegation from Frontenac County's CAO Kelly Pender & Director of Planning & Ec. Dev Joe Gallivan, concerning Communal Servicing Options.
- Council entertained a delegation from Pat Evans concerning Parkinson's Awareness & endorsed the request to annually proclaim April as Parkinson's Awareness Month.
- The draft Flag/Acknowledgements Policy was discussed and will be brought back for approval at the April 8th regular meeting.
- Council approved a \$500 donation on behalf of the Village towards the food drive spearheaded by the Chief Fire Officers Association of Leeds and Grenville, & challenged our neighbouring Municipalities to do so as well.
- A petition for traffic calming measures to improve pedestrian safety & encourage commerce on the north side was received & will be discussed at the April 22, 2024 Committee of the Whole meeting.
- Deputy Mayor Barr's Notice of Motion pertaining to a water rate study was passed.
- Deputy Mayor Barr gave a brief summary and showed images of the Community Centre renovation grant application.
