**Quotation No. PW RFQ 21-05 for
Screened Winter Sand for 2021 - 2022**

The Public Works Department invites price quotations for the supply and delivery of screened winter sand to Merrickville-Wolford Public works garage on Roses Bridge Road.

You are invited to submit a sealed quotation for one or more of the following requirements. The quoted price shall remain in effect for the duration of the 2021-2022 winter maintenance seasons. Additional sand if required at one or more locations during the course of the winter season shall be supplied at the quoted price.

Location	1.	Wolford Garage 495 Roses Bridge Road Easton's Corners	Up to 2000 tonnes
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Quotations may be submitted on the form provided and delivered in a sealed envelope or by email.

The following conditions shall apply to the supply of screened winter sand under this tender:

1. Material shall conform to OPSS 1004. Paragraph 1004.05.05. All material supplied shall be screened and clear of any coarse aggregate.
2. Work shall be completed by October 31st, 2021.
3. The winter sand shall be dumped on the asphalt apron in front of the sand dome from where it shall be mixed and stockpiled in the sand dome the Municipality will supply the loader to load the stacker.
4. The Contractor shall supply a stacker with operator having sufficient length to elevate sand to the full capacity of the dome. The price of stacker shall be included in the unit price per tonne quoted herein.
5. Quotations should be based on a unit price per tonne of screened winter sand supplied. Scales shall be supplied by Contractor.

- a. If the Contractor commits any act of bankruptcy; or if a receiver is appointed on account of its insolvency or in respect of any of its property; or if the Contractor makes a general assignment for the benefit of its creditor; then, in any such case, the Municipality may, without notice; terminate the contract.
 - b. If the Contractor fails to comply with any request, instruction or order of the Municipality; or fails to pay its accounts; or fails to comply with or persistently disregards statutes, regulations, by-laws or directives or relevant authorities relating to the work; or fails to prosecute the work with skill and diligence; or assigns or sublets the contract without the Municipality s' written consent, or refuses to correct defective work; or is otherwise in default in carrying out its part of any of the terms, conditions and obligations of the contract or fails to provide material(s) as per the contract's specifications; then, in any such case, the Municipality may upon expiration of ten days from the date of written notice to the Contractor, terminate the contract.
 - c. Any termination of the contract by the Municipality, as aforesaid, shall be without prejudice to any other rights or remedies the Municipality may have.
7. If the Municipality terminates the contract, it is entitled to:
 - a. take possession of all work in progress and finish the work by whatever means the Municipality may deem appropriate under the circumstances; withhold any further payments to the Contractor until its liability to the Municipality can be ascertained;
 - b. recover from the Contractor, the expense incurred between the monetary difference

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- in the awarded contracted material cost and the bid price of an alternate supplier;
recover from the Contractor, loss, damage and expense incurred by the Municipality
- c. and by reason of the Contractor's default (which may be deducted from any monies due or becoming due to the Contractor, or any holdback to be paid by the Municipality).

8. Payment in the amount of the value of material delivered shall be made within 30 days upon receipt of invoice
9. Prices quoted must include all applicable Provincial Taxes. which will be paid as an extra to the price quoted.
10. The Municipality reserves the right to accept the quotation it deems to be in its best interest. In particular, since the quality of screened winter sand varies considerably depending on its source, the Municipality assessment of the quality of the sand may influence the award of the quotation. The Municipality may sample the material during production and/or delivery for the purpose of acceptance.
