

CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF MERRICKVILLE - WOLFORD

BY-LAW NO. 38-2021

BEING a By-law to amend By-law 65-2019 of the Corporation of the Village of Merrickville-Wolford, being a by-law to appoint an Emergency Management Program Committee, Municipal Emergency Control Group, Emergency Management Program Co-ordinator and Alternate, and Emergency Information Officer

WHEREAS Section 5(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a Council shall exercise its powers by by-law;

AND WHEREAS under the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*, R.S.O. 1990, and Ontario Regulation 380/04 (the "Act") every municipality in the province is required to appoint an Emergency Management Program Committee, an Emergency Management Control Group, an Emergency Management Program Co-ordinator, and an Emergency Information Officer;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Merrickville - Wolford did pass By-law 65-2019, a by-law to make such appointments;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Merrickville-Wolford enacts as follows:

1. By-law 65-2019 is hereby amended as follows:

"1. The Emergency Management Program Committee Terms of Reference form part of this by-law as Schedule "A" and are hereby adopted.

2. The persons holding the following positions in the Village are appointed as members of the Municipal Emergency Control Group (MECG):


- a. Head of Council (Mayor);
- b. Chief Administrative Officer (CAO);
- c. Emergency Management Program Co-ordinator;
- d. Fire Chief;
- e. Manager, Operations;
- f. Manager of Finance/Treasurer;
- g. Chief Building Official; and
- h. Emergency Information Officer.

3. The Fire Chief is appointed as the Emergency Management Program Co-ordinator.
4. The Chief Administrative Officer is appointed as the Alternate Emergency Management Program Co-ordinator.
5. The Receptionist is appointed as the Emergency Information Officer.
6. By-law 03-2018 any other by-law that is not in conformance with this by-law is hereby repealed."


2. This by-law shall be deemed to come into force and effect upon passing.

READ a third and final time and passed this 28th day of June, 2021
