# 2012 Budget—3.5% increase

Council approved a 3.5% increase in the 2012 budget at the Council meeting held April 23, 2012. This represents an increase in the municipal portion of the 2012 tax bill of \$54.79 on a property assessed at \$200,000.00.

Council also approved a 5% increase in the Environment Budget (Water and Sewer). This increases bi-monthly base rate to \$129.97.

# Cost of Garbage Tags to Increase July 1, 2012

The cost of bag tags will increase effective July 1, 2012. Tags for the Wolford Ward will be \$0.75 and Merrickville Ward will be \$1.50.

Council is also reviewing the current recycling contract, the possibility of implementing mandatory clear garbage bags and a cashless payment system at the landfill site in response to the Integrated Waste Management Plan.
