Old Business:

• Eastons Corners playground committee planning to be part of a fundraising ball tournament on June 1st and 2nd at the Eastons Corners ball diamonds

 4 stages of work plan – a copy of the schedule of renovations will be requested with and invitation for those who have previously used the hall to provide input (e.g. church groups, playground committee, etc.)

New Business:

Item #1 (Mike Hanna to discussed erecting the batting cage)

- All the piping to put up batting cage will cost approximately \$350.00
- Additional costs will be incurred for cement
- Will require power
- Mike will donate his time to put it together
- Ball machine will require a locked space to store it possibly inside the rink area in Eastons Corners after each use
- Advised that no further action occur without direction from council.

Item #2 (Inquiry about use of Merrickville Ball Diamond – Tommy Burchill)

- There is a significant increase in interest in the area for hardball opportunities
- Kemptville is looking for diamonds and are presently renting space in Winchester
- Kids in Smiths Falls presently going to Lanark for opportunity to play
- Both areas could potentially be drawn to Merrickville diamond
- Merrickville diamond could be switched to hardball with some work such as extending the infield and increasing the height of the pitcher's mound
- Would also require netting of some sort be put up due to location of playground structure which could result in injury to kids playing on the structure while ball game occurring
- Little league is usually 6:15 p.m. start time
- Over 13 year old category usual start time is 8:00 p.m.
- This could be done on alternate days that soccer is occurring or, for older groups, on same nights as soccer (when it is done)
- Even one night of ball would get one team of each age group playing
- Interested kids would possibly be motivated to join as they see the games occurring

Item #3 (Use of ball diamond for fair rides)

- Concerns around the safety of children presently playing soccer and potential ball teams using the field,
- it is recommended that a motion be made to prevent fair rides from using the ball field as damage occurs as a result and results in ruts, potholes and generally uneven ground where kids are playing sports
